It has been lovely seeing many of you in the playground and catching up with the wonderful Christmas recounts, once again it appears that the children at All Saints' have been very good because Santa has been extremely generous this year!! We have a wealth of exciting things and events happening in 2015 and I feel confident that it is going to be another very happy and successful year with continued high academic results coupled with exciting learning opportunities.

School Review Day

In November school had a Review Day lead by senior staff from the authority and the outcome was extremely positive. The team looked at all aspects of the school and recognised how inclusive All Saints' is and how proud children are to be part of the school. The children told the team;

They praise the work of adults in school who 'listen to what we have to say and don't allow us to stay upset.'

Pupils say that this is a safe school and 'we learn and have fun and have friends' and that there is 'nowhere in our school where we don't feel safe'.

The team found:

There were excellent examples of deep and meaningful experiences given to pupils' spiritual, moral, social and cultural development during the review.

There is a culture of valuing the contribution made by all in school. Consequently, individual strengths and skills are harnessed for the benefit of the pupils in school. Teaching is good and is well matched to pupils' needs and abilities.

We as a school are extremely proud of the way in which the children behaved during this visit and the feedback that we received as a result of this, and the efforts of the staff.

With regards to the recent Government Performance and League Tables we are aware that, as an inclusive school, our children's skills and talents are not always reflected in these publications. While it is not always possible for all our children to achieve the national standard of Level 4 we are very proud of the continued progress of all the children in school academically, socially and emotionally -something All Saints' will always celebrate.
