Summer Menu 2018

The Summer Menu is still being enjoyed by many as the Autumn approaches. Favourites have included the Cone Bakes, Bubblecrumb Salmon, Chicken Supreme, Paella and all the desserts! A few tweaks to the menu were plain Cod Bites and plain sliced gammon, which were served in addition to the Fish and Chip Bites and the Gammon and Sweetcorn Gratin. Picnic Day, and the fabulous summer we have had has enabled many opportunities for the children to dine outside. We are hoping the remaining few weeks will stay fine to give the new Year 1 the chance to picnic outside too.

The summer menu will continue until after half term.

Parents of Foundation children will be issued with a menu to encourage children with their choices on a daily basis. It is a good idea to familiarise them as this helps with service. Parents of new children with allergies should contact me as soon as possible to discuss their needs. School meals are free to all Key Stage 1 children.

The cost of a meal for all Key Stage 2 children remains at £1.90 per day.

Free School Meals Information

As mentioned previously, and as you may already be aware, all Key Stage 1 children (Foundation to Year 2) are eligible to receive a free school meal under the government initiative of Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM). However, it is vital that parents who are eligible for Free School Meal benefits still apply for this support. The number of pupils receiving the free school meal benefits remains a major criteria in calculating the allocation of budgets and grants in school. This extra funding is used by the school to support your child's learning. In addition to this, school is offering a voucher to the value of £15 which can be used towards an item of school uniform for your child. This will be issued by the school office once your Free School Meals entitlement has been confirmed by Bradford Council.

"Did you Know?.....Feature".....

The reinvention of macaroni cheese is a success for Britain's eating out sector.

The popularity of the humble macaroni cheese continues as 'mac n' cheese clocks growth of over 550% on British restaurant menus since 2010, according to a new survey.

Mac 'n' cheese has become a firm favourite on British menus loved by both consumers and restaurant operators who can add simple twists to the classic dish with the addition of a range of ingredients or crunch toppings for a relatively low price. The dish is also being served in restaurants in a variety of ways such as inside a burger or calzone or as a side dish. Macaroni cheese was once a cheap, comfort food for home cooking but has now become a favourite on menus. It's a huge success story for restaurants and pubs and shows that chefs have returned to some of our old favourites by giving them a new twist with modern ingredients.

Macaroni cheese featured in Mrs Beeton's Victorian cookery books but its reinvention in the US as mac 'n' cheese gave it a new life in the UK bringing the dish to an audience of younger diners. Operators love it because it's cheap and quick and easy to produce, offering good margins and is easily revamped with the addition of other ingredients.

Our children have always loved Macaroni cheese - currently on our Summer Menu and regularly appear in some form i.e. Cheesy Pasta, Cauliflower Macaroni etc. Simple to make and loved by many!
