Home learning spellings



This week you will be learning the alternative 'a' sound. You already know the letter 'a' can make an /a/ sound in 'hat' and an /ai/ sound in 'angel', 'bacon' and 'lady'.

Sometimes, the letter 'a' can also make an $/\sigma/$ sound in 'was', 'wanted' and 'watching'. Practise these alternative pronunciations using the activities on this week's weekly plan.

You also have 2 tricky words in your spellings to practise this week, 'made' and 'came'.
