Action word focus

Activity 2

Literacy

Discuss some features of a letter/card. What do we write first? Where do we write our name? Think of some things you would like to ask your teacher. 'What is my new classroom like?' 'Where do we play outside?'. You can bring your letter in to your new teacher next Wednesday!

Activity 3

Topic - Expressive Arts & Design

Numeracy-

Exploring nature

Literacy

Camping/holiday checklist!

Some of you may be going camping or on holiday this summer. Depending on where you are going, can you write a list of the things you will need to take with you. (toothbrush, pyjamas, suncream...). Even if you aren't going anywhere, you can go on an imaginary adventure! Use bullet points or numbers to order your list.

Topic - Knowledge & Understanding

Could you use some non-fiction books or the internet to research a country you would like to visit. It could be somewhere exotic or maybe somewhere you have visited previously. Can you find out what animals live there, what the weather is like, are there deserts/jungles/famous landmarks/what is looks like on a map/flag. Have a go at drawing and labelling some of your interesting research!



Numeracy

Hopefully the weather will be kind to us this week. Get the paddling pool out or a big bowl of water outside. Gather a variety of different sized containers and explore capacity. Is the jug full/empty/half full? Have some fun and make some imaginary drinks! Use challenge questions such as 'How many cups do you think this full bowl fill?'

Recap all sounds revisited this week.

Follow the link below and watch the high frequency words under the sea. Encourage your child to shout out what the word is being read. Pause a few times and practise writing some of these words on lines with the correct letter formation.
