WORD	DEFINITION
Weather	Conditions created by day to day changes in the earth's atmosphere.
Winter	The coldest season of the year. It occurs between autumn and spring
Season	The year is split up in to 4 seasons, marked by particular weather patterns.
Icicles	A mass of ice formed by freezing dripping water
Freeze	Liquid turning to ice in extreme cold.
Wind	Natural movement of air
Snow	Water frozen into ice and falling in white flakes or as a white layer.
Path	A track for walking.
Road	A wide way leading to another place with a prepared surface.
Town	A built up area, larger than a village and smaller than a city.

- ❖ Winter is a season {Spring, Summer, Autumn Winter}
- ❖ The weather is usually cold, windy, wet, snowy.
- ❖ The months of winter are November, December, January and February.
- ❖ Winter weather in arctic and Antarctic
- ❖ Animals in the Arctic and Antarctic – penguins, snow leopards, snow foxes, polar bears, seals, whales.
- ❖ We wear winter clothes – scarf, hat, winter coat, wellingtons, waterproofs.
- ❖ Making snow people using our hands and sculpting.
