## Mary Anning

### Key Knowledge/events and facts

- ❖ Mary Anning was born in 1799.
- ❖ She lived by the coast in Lyme Regis. This coast is known as the Jurassic Coast.
- ❖ Dinosaurs existed millions of years ago before humans lived on earth. They are now extinct. When they became extinct, their remains were left behind as fossils.
- ❖ Mary collected fossils on the beach as a child which she called curiosities.
- ❖ Her father taught her how to get fossils out of the rock using a hammer and a chisel.
- ❖ As an adult, Mary made many important fossil discoveries which changed what we know about the world today.
- ❖ She found a giant fossil that no one had seen before. It was a giant creature called an Ichthyosaurus.
- ❖ The men of science who came to see her discoveries did not give Mary any credit for what she found as she was a woman and poor.
