Children's Interests

We will continue following the children's interests and ensure they are engaged and excited about their learning.

Phonics

Maths

- We will be looking at doubles, odd and even numbers and making numbers up to 20 using tens frames.
- We will be counting things that can't be seen (e.g. actions) & counting larger sets of objects.

 Looking at 'How can we care for our wonderful world?' Looking at all the things in our world that make it so special – plants, animals, trees, flowers, rivers etc.
