When asked if they liked sharing... *"It was fun! I'm not normally someone who would stand at the front and read out my work, but it was really nice to share and feel proud"*

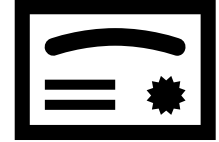
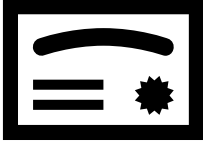
The Year 6's then gave our Year 3's some top tips
